Auditor Miller:

I am writing in regard to the incident involving the accidental transmission of the last four digits of social security numbers for over 200,000 residents of Linn County from your office to three confirmed officials with the Linn County Republican Party.

While I have appreciated your timely response to the matter and the briefing provided by Deputy Auditor Rebecca Stonawski, I am requesting that you keep the Linn County Board of Supervisors apprised of the situation, including any key developments and progress on plans to rectify the situation.

Given that the Board of Supervisors has the responsibility of allocating budget funds to county departments and a responsibility to the residents of the county should additional protective measures be needed, I would appreciate a full report on the costs of these measures and the level of protection they afford.

I would also appreciate regular progress reports on the effort to identify and establish contact with the fourth recipient of the information.

I trust you will find my request reasonable and I trust you will understand the relevance of this information to my duties as a Supervisor for Linn County.
